[Find the easiest way to get proof](#) of your COVID-19 vaccinations based on your situation.

There are 3 [different types of proof available](#) that you can get for free:

- a COVID-19 digital certificate
- your immunisation history statement (IHS)
- an International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate for overseas travel.

The COVID-19 Digital Certificate or IHS can be viewed and/or printed through:

- Medicare Online via MyGov
- [Express Plus Medicare mobile app](#)
- [My Health Record](#)

Everyone in Australia can get a free, safe and effective COVID-19 vaccine. This includes overseas visitors, international students, migrant workers and asylum seekers. Read about [how to get the vaccine](#) and when.

If you're not eligible for Medicare or Department of Veteran's Affairs (DVA) benefits, you can get proof of your vaccinations and see other important health information through My Health Record. Please see further information here about how to set up a My Health Record:

If you can't use online channels, your vaccination provider can print your immunisation history statement for you. Individuals can also call the AIR and ask to be sent their immunisation history statement. This can take up to 14 days to arrive in the post.
