 - Cataloguing and storage of archival records

4. Recommend to the Board and oversee projects relating to conservation, cataloguing and display.
5. Recommend to the Board and oversee projects relating to the history of AMA Victoria.
6. Liaise with appropriate officers at institutions such as the University of Melbourne and the Learned Colleges on matters of mutual interest connected with Victorian medical history and archives.
